Position or NROI Representative for NSW.

Jim Staader nominated Himself for the Position. Seconded by Diana Williams. Jim Staader has accepted.

General Business.

Nominations were asked from any Club who would like to hold the 2010 NSW State Titles. Delegates are to discuss with their respective Clubs, to see who may be interested.

Robert Tucker advised that Grafton is hosting the 2009 State Titles on the 6th and 7th March 2009. Competitor numbers will be limited to around 100-120. NSW Members will be given preference on entry, but will have constraints, based on number of entries and time of entry. The entry form will be placed onto the NSW website within the next few weeks.

Scot Taylor asked whether we will be sending NSW teams to the 2009 Nationals. This was raised as it has become difficult to obtain accommodation in Darwin as a result of the Arafura Games. Sam Lopresti has been able to secure some rooms for Team Members, and NSW will be sending Teams. Individual Competitors are strongly advised to secure their own accommodation as early as possible.

Dave Crittenden asked how members can find their current grade.

Glenn Land advised that following the National IPSC AGM, Gareth Graham, (the Regional Director) is responsible for advising grade changes. Following Selection matches, and State Titles, Grade change recommendations are to be forwarded to Gareth for approval. Gareth will then determine if it is appropriate for a Competitor to have his grade changed.

Brian Blight requested that we ask Gareth for the criteria he will use in determining if a Competitors grade should be changed. IPSC NSW will forward the request.

NSW Clubs can run a grading match, following the criteria set out on the Australian IPSC Website. Results from this grading match, should then be forwarded to IPSC NSW to be processed and noted in the Members Database.

Adrian Keed raised the point of the additional cost for late entries, and for paying the entry fee on the day of the match.

The reason for Blacktown and Grafton, imposing a late fee for late entries, and also requiring payment at the time of entry, is to assist Clubs in organizing score sheets, squading lists and catering for each Competition. This topic was discussed at great depth, and it was noted that IPSC NSW can not tell Clubs how to conduct their match. IPSC Matches that are held at various Clubs, are subject to the requirements of the individual Club Committees.

It was suggested that IPSC NSW, recommend to each Club that maybe they can have an Entry Fee, Late entry Fee, and a Refund time, where Competitors can advise the Club that they cannot attend, and receive a full refund of their entry.
