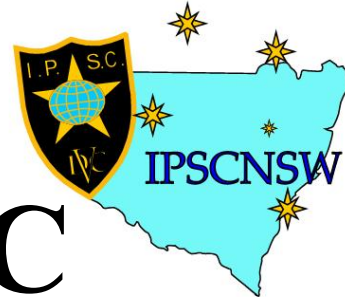

Newcastle Pistol Club will be requiring Range Officers to assist for this match. The match will be a level 2 and therefore range officers will be able to shoot with their squad during the course of the match (non static RO's). Range Officers will be provided lunch and drinks throughout each day. If you would like to help us out by volunteering to be a RO over the weekend can you please contact **Jim Staader** by the 2nd of March 2012 or by nomination on the bottom of the entry form.

Gun checks will start on Friday the 9th of March after 2 pm and from 7.30 am Saturday the 10th March.
All competitors will undergo chronograph testing during the match.

Also a reminder that **Newcastle Pistol Club** is not a licensed club, food and drinks will be available from the club canteen .

Car parking within the pistol club and rifle range complex is limited, so it is recommended that car pooling from your motel/hotel be undertaken. Once the car parks are full, it is recommended that people access the club to drop off passengers and gear then park in the surrounding streets and walk the short distance back to the club.

NO hardball or jacketed ammunition is allowed to be discharged within the Newcastle Pistol Club & the Newcastle Small Bore Rifle Clubs complex.

I am aware that participating in IPSC competition is a potentially dangerous undertaking and that I participate in that activity at my own risk. I acknowledge that the Competition Organizers, (which term includes all persons involved in the designing, constructing and administering the competition, the host Club, its Committee, members, servants or agents), cannot control a range of matters that will create or vary risks to my health and safety. Such things include the weather, deterioration of range surfaces through use, personal attributes such as my fitness and level of expertise and my approach to the challenges presented in this competition.

I am also aware that it is a condition of my entry into this competition that I waive all rights I might otherwise hold against the Competition Organizers. I release the Competition Organizers from all liability any of them might later have to me for or arising out of any injury to me caused in any way by my participation in the competition or by any other way whatsoever due to any negligent act, breach of duty, default and/or omission on the part of the Competition Organizers.

I am also aware that any person participating in IPSC competition at this range is only allowed to do so on the distinct understanding that they do so at their own risk.

I also agree to compete and participate in the match in a spirit of sportsmanship and cooperation with the match organizers and my squad. This includes being on time and present for every stage briefing, assisting in patching, scoring and collection of brass during the running of stages in an effort to keep the match running efficiently. By signing this waiver I agree to be subject to whatever disciplinary action is taken by the Match Director or CRO in respect of my conduct at the match.

I also understand the match organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the match without warning, before or during the match due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If the match is cancelled or postponed the match organisers cannot be held responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by the competitor due to the cancellation or postponement of the match. In the event the match is cancelled:

- (a) before the start of the competition, the entry fee will be refunded less an administration cost.
- (b) where the match has commenced, a refund of the entry fee will be at the discretion of the match organisers.

My signature below acknowledges that of my own free will and desire I have contracted with the Competition Organizers to participate in IPSC competition and that I have read and understood the warning, and release from liability and waiver stated above, and agree to be bound by it as a condition of my entry into this competition.
