SAFETY

Even though the Bushranger Shoot is promoted as one of the more informal non-sanctioned IPSC style events we must adhere to the IPSC safety rules.

As safety is the most important aspect of our sport everyone should have a basic understanding of the safety requirements when you are on the ranges, and for handling and storage of firearms when not in use. RANGE OFFICER DUTY

As the aforementioned, this is an informal IPSC style match and **ALL** competitors are asked to participate in the general running of the stages as either Range Officer or Scorer/Patcher.

If you are helping with scoring, please make sure you fill out the score sheets correctly. The Match Committee was informed of several common mistakes being made in previous years. Please ensure all targets are scored and a TIME is recorded and that the score sheets are signed. Your accuracy in filling out score sheets may determine the outcome of the match
