



How to Compete in IPSC –

<p>1. Hold a Category H Firearms Licence (or PPL past the first 6 months).</p>	<p>Membership of a Police approved shooting or firearms club is a requirement to obtaining a licence and your club will provide the training and assistance required.</p>
<p>2. Have a suitable firearm, holster, belt and mag pouches to suit the IPSC division you want to compete in.</p>	<p>The IPSC Australia website (www.ipsc.org.au/contacts/fag/handguns) has good info on which types of firearms are popular in the various IPSC divisions.</p>
<p>3. Be a member of an IPSC Australia affiliated club.</p>	<p>This is a requirement of IPSC membership rules. If your club is not already affiliated, you should ask them if they'd like to affiliate, as it is a simple process. Club affiliation can be done online (https://members.ipsc.org.au/#join-club)</p>
<p>4. Complete the IPSC Australia Safety and Holster training course (generally 8 hours over one or two days).</p>	<p>You must arrange for your IPSC safety and Holster training course through your club or contact your local IPSC Section Coordinator. A copy of your holster course results must go to your state IPSC section to verify your IPSC membership.</p>
<p>5. Become a personal member of IPSC Australia.</p>	<p>This is also a requirement of IPSC membership rules and includes insurance cover at Level 2 and higher matches. You can join online, (https://members.ipsc.org.au/#join-members) but membership will only be verified if you are a member of an affiliated club and have completed the IPSCA Safety and Holster course.</p>

The easiest process – Once you have satisfied items 1, 2 & 3 above you should arrange to do the IPSC Safety and Holster course and then join IPSC online. IPSC Australia will verify your holster course results with your IPSC state coordinator and then issue you an IPSCA membership card.
