All Firearms must be bagged and un-bagged in Safety Areas only.

Handling of Ammunition is NOT permitted in Safety Areas.

Holstered Firearms are permitted in the Clubhouse and Club Deck Area. No handling of firearms is permitted in the Car park.

Magazines or handling of Ammunition is not permitted in the Clubhouse or Club Deck Area.

VIDEOS or STILL PHOTOGRAPHY IS NOT PERMITTED ON ANY RANGE.

CLUB RULES

- 1. All MEMBERS and VISITORS MUST SIGN the appropriate Register upon arrival.
- 2. **NO** unsupervised children allowed on the range.
- 3. **OPEN FOOTWEAR** (eg thongs, scuffs or sandals) is **NOT** recognised as appropriate footwear for this sport.
- 4. **HEARING** protection to be worn at all times by all persons on the Range while matches are in progress.
- 5. **EYE** protection must be worn by all shooters and spectators on all Live Fire Ranges.
- 6. **ACTIVE MOBILE PHONES** are **NOT PERMITTED** on the Ranges where matches are being held.
- 7. **ALL SPECTATORS** are to remain behind fences or contestant lines while matches are in progress.
- 8. **NO FIREARMS** to be handled on any Range where **Shooters** and **Scorers** are forward of the firing line.
- 9. **NO FIREARMS** to be removed from the firing line until cleared by the **RANGE OFFICER** or **TRAINER**.
- 10. **ALL FIREARMS** on Ranges are to be pointed down Range at all times.
- 11. **NO ALCOHOL** is permitted on the Club ground without the consent of the Committee of Management, **NO PERSON** who having consumed **ALCOHOL** is permitted to use any firearm on any Range.
- 12. **NO SMOKING** in the **Clubhouse**, on the Range and in Alleyways or Entrances, or in the **BBQ area** at anytime.
- 13. **YOU** must wear a **NAME TAG** and have your Shooters Licence on your person for inspection on request by Club Secretary or Club Official whilst on Club grounds.
- 14. **YOU MUST** abide by the regulations set by the **FIREARMS ACT** Clause 96 to hold and maintain YOUR category H licence.
- 15. The appropriate **FLAGS MUST FLY** whilst any person is shooting on the Range.






