IPSCA Safety and Holster Course - NSW

Completing this course is a pre-requisite for competing in IPSC in Australia and overseas. The training provided by this course is intended to ensure safe competition to both protect the members and the sport.

In October 2021 IPSC Australia revised the Safety and Holster training course to include a practical test to be completed by an external assessor. This is now in use by all sections of IPSC Australia.

The training course is in two parts.

Part 1 - Prospective IPSC Members are trained by their trainers within IPSC Affiliated Pistol Clubs. All Trainers must be current financial IPSC members who are holster proficient, to ensure compliance with insurance requirements.

Parts 2 - After club training a final external assessment is required for all new IPSC members prior to open competition. The final assessor must be one of the Assessors appointed by IPSC NSW, and must not be that member's trainer.

When a club considers a new member is ready for the assessment, the club's Trainer should contact IPSC NSW to arrange for an assessment to be conducted. IPSC NSW has several assessors across NSW.
