



How to Compete in IPSC, in NSW –

<p>1. Hold a Category H Firearms Licence (or PPL past the first 6 months).</p>	<p>Membership of a NSW Police approved shooting or firearms club is a requirement to obtaining a licence and your club will provide the basic training and assistance required by the licence. On a PPL you must be under the supervision of your club for the first 6 months.</p>
<p>2. Have a suitable firearm, magazines, holster, belt and magazine pouches to suit the IPSC division you want to compete in.</p>	<p>The IPSC Australia website has good info on which types of firearms are popular in the various IPSC divisions – link - https://ipsc.org.au/disciplines-handgun/. The IPSC rule book lists the restrictions on holsters, pouches etc.</p>
<p>3. Be a member of an IPSC affiliated club.</p>	<p>This is a requirement of IPSC Australia membership rules. It is also to comply with the NSW Firearms Registry and National Firearms Agreement rules that your club must be affiliated with IPSC to be able to conduct IPSC activities. <p>4. Be a personal member of IPSC Australia.</p>	<p>This is also a requirement of IPSC membership rules and includes insurance cover. You can join online at the IPSC Australia website. A membership card will only be created once affiliated club membership and the IPSCA Safety and Holster course are verified. Link to members portal - https://members.ipsc.org.au/</p>
<p>5. Complete the IPSC Australia Safety and Holster Proficiency training course.</p>	<p>You must arrange for your IPSC Safety and Holster training course through your club or through another IPSC club with your club's permission. This will include a final External Assessment by IPSC NSW before you can compete in open competition.</p>
<p>6. Range Approval</p>	<p>To comply with NSW Firearms Registry regulations, all IPSC competitions and practice must be conducted only on ranges with ammunition restrictions that suit IPSC competition.</p>
